## **ALDOT Announces Planned Closures as Work Continues on Anniston Eastern Bypass, in Calhoun**

**CALHOUN**– Weather permitting, on Sunday, July 12, starting at approximately 6 p.m. the Alabama Department of Transportation and its contractor will begin resurfacing the Anniston Eastern Bypass from I-20 to Henry Road which will require lane closures as follows:

- Lane closures on the Anniston Eastern Bypass from I-20 to the US 78 overpass bridge and surrounding areas in each direction for approximately a week for milling and paving and afterwards;
- Lane closures from the US 78 bridge overpass to Henry Road, which will include milling at night and paving during the day.

Lane closures will last for approximately 6 to 8 weeks.

Motorists are also requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area.
