The City Council of the City of Anniston, Alabama, met in Special Session in the Council Chamber in the City Hall of the City of Anniston, Alabama, on Friday, January 29, 2010, at approximately 3:06 o'clock p.m.

Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order. On call of the roll the following Council Members were found to be present: Council Members Spain, Palmore, Little, Dawson and Robinson; absent: none. A quorum was present and the meeting opened for the transaction of business.

Cleo Thomas, City Attorney, was present.

Council Member Spain introduced and read Ordinance Number 10-O-4 as follows:
