Steven Folks prayed the Invocation.

Steven Folks led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

Mayor Stewart called the meeting to order. On call of the roll the following Council Members were found to be present: Council Members Jenkins, Reddick, Selase, Harris and Stewart; absent: none. A quorum was present and the meeting opened for the transaction of business.

Don Hoyt, City Manager, was present.

Bruce Downey, City Attorney, was present.

Council Member Reddick made a motion to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Council Member Jenkins; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Jenkins, Reddick, Selase, Harris and Stewart; nays: none. The motion carried.

The Council discussed the selection of a candidate for City Manager the two candidates being Gerald Smith and Brian Johnson.

Council Member Jenkins introduced and read Resolution Number 13-R-195 as follows:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 13-R-195

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH
A CITY MANAGER CANDIDATE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Anniston, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. That Vaughn M. Stewart II, Mayor of the City of Anniston, Alabama, be and he is hereby authorized, directed and empowered for and in the name of the City of Anniston with advice from the City Attorney to negotiate an employment agreement with Brian Johnson for the position of City Manager, or, if Brian Johnson declines, to negotiate an employment agreement with Gerald Smith for the position of City Manager.

Section 2. That said employment agreement shall be contingent upon approval and ratification by the City Council.

The motion carried and Resolution Number 13-R-195 was passed and adopted.

The motion was seconded by Council Member Reddick; and on call of the roll the following vote was recorded: ayes: Council Members Jenkins, Reddick, Selase, Harris and Stewart; nays: none.
