**July 12 - Creek Walk on Jones Branch in the Duggar Mt. Wilderness Area**

This will be a walking expedition to explore Jones Branch Creek and other possible adjacent areas located in the Duggar Mountain Wilderness Area. Participants should bring a lunch, water, and wear old tennis shoes or water shoes. The meeting location and time for this outing will be 9:00 a.m. at the Pinkey Burns trailhead located on Cleburne County Road 55 (Rabittown Road). **July 26 - Tubing Trip on Choccolocco Creek**

This will be a 2 hour relaxing float trip on Choccolocco Creek. Plans are to use the services of Floating Fun for this outing. Floating Fun rents tubes for \$15.00 which includes the tube, a PDF, the shuttle, and a push off stick. Those planning to participate should make reservations directly through Floating Fun's website at [www.floatingfun.net](http://www.floatingfun.net) or by calling 256-591-0437 or 256-588-4418. Participants should wear clothes they don't mind getting wet, closed toed water shoes, a hat and sunscreen. A lunch and plenty of water should also be brought. Optional cooler floats are available for \$10.00, however lunches can be placed in a dry bag or small cooler and attached to your tube. The meeting time and location for this outing will be 9:00 am from the Piggly Wiggly in Anniston or 9:30 am at Floating Fun. Direction to Floating Fun are as follows: Take Exit 179 off Interstate 20 onto Priebe Mill Road. Travel southwest on Priebe Mill Road for one half mile to first road on the left which is Bobwhite Drive. Take a left onto Bobwhite Drive and proceed south for one half mile to a red gate which will be on the right.
