June 8 - Second Saturday Pinhoti Day Hike

This will be the sixth in a series of second Saturday hikes being offered by the AOA and JSU Field School with the goal of section hiking the entire Pinhoti Trail in Alabama. This month's hike will be the last hike until September and will be a 6.6 mile trek beginning at the Burns Trailhead located on Cleburne County Rd 55 and ending on USFS Road 640. This section of the Pinhoti is rated moderate and features the Choccolocco Trail Shelter, the Choccolocco Watershed Lake, Twenty Feet Creek, and several other creek crossings. Since this will be a June hike, come prepared to encounter poison ivy/oak, gnats, ticks, bees, and possibly snakes. Participants should pack a lunch with plenty of water. Sunscreen and insect repellent are also recommended.
