Interstate Sheet Metal makes over \$1.6M capital investment, adds jobs

Interstate Sheet Metal will be expanding its Anniston facility located at 1528 ITC Way.

“We are excited to be expanding our Anniston footprint and appreciate the support from the City to make this project possible,” said Interstate Sheet Metal Partner Hank Smith.

Interstate Sheet Metal estimates a \$1,670,000 capital investment and up to eight additional jobs. This expansion will support the acquisition and installation of a powder coating operation.

“The City Council is glad to hear of the new technology that’s being invested into Interstate Sheet Metal’s Anniston plant,” said Anniston Mayor Vaughn Stewart. “When your local manufacturers are doing well that’s a good sign for your business climate.”

The Anniston Industrial Development Authority approved an abatement request for the non-educational property, sales and use taxes; the non-educational property taxes were abated for a period of 10 years.

“This incentive was necessary to encourage Interstate Sheet Metal to continue to invest in their Anniston location and grow jobs in our community,” said Dr. Dawn Wilczek, chair of the Anniston Industrial Development Authority.
