

**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

SEALED BIDS WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF ANNISTON AT 1128 GURNEE AVENUE, ANNISTON, ALABAMA, UNTIL 2.00 P.M., APRIL 10, 2015, AND AT THAT TIME PUBLICLY OPENED FOR CONSTRUCTING THE FOLLOWING:

RECONSTRUCTION OF APPROXIMATELY 2,300 FEET OF 17TH STREET IN ANNISTON, ALABAMA

THE PRINCIPAL ITEMS OF WORK ARE APPROXIMATELY AS FOLLOWS:

PLANING AND RESURFACING 17TH STREET FROM GLENADDIE AVENUE TO STEPHENS AVENUE

THE ENTIRE PROJECT SHALL BE COMPLETED IN THIRTY (30) WORKING DAYS.

BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON COMPLETE ORIGINAL PROPOSALS MADE AVAILABLE BY THE OWNER. BID DOCUMENTS (INCLUDING ANY PLANS AND PROPOSALS) ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS OFFICE AT 1128 GURNEE AVENUE, ANNISTON, ALABAMA 36201, BEGINNING AT 10.00 A.M. ON MARCH 27, 2015. NO BID DOCUMENTS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED LATER THAN 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED OPENING OF BIDS.

A CASHIER'S CHECK (DRAWN ON AN ALABAMA BANK) OR BID BOND FOR 5% OF THE AMOUNT BID (MAXIMUM OF \$10,000.00) AND MADE PAYABLE TO THE CITY OF ANNISTON MUST ACCOMPANY EACH BID AS EVIDENCE OF GOOD FAITH.

IT IS REQUIRED THAT A CONTRACTOR BE LICENSED IN ORDER TO SUBMIT A BID. PROOF OF INSURANCE COVERAGES OF THE TYPES AND AMOUNTS AS SET FORTH IN THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED OF THE CONTRACTOR, AND ANY AND ALL SUBCONTRACTORS, PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK. THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO PERFORM WORK AMOUNTING TO AT LEAST 30% OF THE TOTAL CONTRACT COST WITH HIS OWN ORGANIZATION.

THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT WILL NOT BE MADE TO ANY BIDDER WHO, AT THE TIME OF THE AWARD, IS CONSIDERED BY THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ALDOT) TO BE DISQUALIFIED FROM BIDDING, NOR TO ANY BIDDER WHO IS AN AFFILIATE OF OR HAS A CORPORATE OFFICER, DIRECTOR, OR PRINCIPAL OWNER WHO IS A CORPORATE OFFICER, DIRECTOR, OR OWNER OF, ANOTHER PERSON WHO IS PRESENTLY DISQUALIFIED BY ALDOT.

THIS IS A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDED PROJECT. THE PROPOSED WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN CONFORMITY WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CARRYING OUT ANY ACTS, AMENDMENTS, SUPPLEMENTARY, OR RELATIVE THERETO OF A CONSTRUCTION PROJECT USING CDBG FUNDING. THIS PROJECT IS SUBJECT TO THE CONTRACT WORK HOURS AND SAFETY STANDARDS ACT AND IT'S IMPLEMENTING REGULATIONS. MBE/DBE PARTICIPATION IS ENCOURAGED; HOWEVER, NO SPECIFIC MBE/DBE GOALS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR THIS PROJECT.

MINIMUM WAGE RATES FOR THIS PROJECT HAVE BEEN PRE-DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY OF LABOR AND ARE SET FORTH IN THE ADVERTISED SPECIFICATIONS.
