- ❑ Develops a strategy to target federal resources in areas with greatest concentrations of poverty and blight

- ❑ Expand affordable housing opportunities
- ❑ Planning and Administration
- ❑ Public Housing - Housing/Services for Homeless/At-Risk
- ❑ Public Services - Services for the homeless and at-risk populations
- ❑ Neighborhood Redevelopment/ Facility Improvements in Low-Mod Areas
  - Infrastructure Improvements through clearance and demolition
  - Redevelopment activities in LMI areas, including Section 108 loans

## UPDATES

The City of Anniston held 2 Needs Assessment meetings and received 85 surveys responses. The needs assessment and survey revealed the following needs:

- ❑ Increase services for homeless and disabled persons
- ❑ Create more options for subsidized and transitional housing for low income and homeless persons
- ❑ Increase targeted investment for economic development and job creation in West Anniston
- ❑ Enhance transportation alternatives for low-income households
