The City of Anniston, would like its citizens to be aware that the Alabama Dept. of Public Health made it known to the public, at 10:05AM today through an update to their website, that Calhoun County has one confirmed case of COVID-19 as of 03/18/20 at 11:10AM (Link: <https://bit.ly/3b4PZdH>).

At this time, the Alabama Dept. of Public Health has adopted the policy of not sharing the personal information of a confirmed COVID-19 patient, as to protect their personal privacy. That being said, Anniston city leadership urges all of its citizens to continue social distancing practices, and to adhere to the health and safety guidelines set forth by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, as well as the Alabama Dept. of Public Health. If additional details arise, in regard to this situation, we will promptly notify the public.
