In order to limit and slow the spread of COVID-19, and in the best interests of both the drivers and passengers, effective today, **April 1st**, the Anniston Calhoun Transit System (ACTS) fixed route will now allow only **5 passengers on the vehicle at any one time**. In addition, fares are currently being waived, and Paratransit and Demand Response services will continue to provide essential transportation trips.
