In order to limit and slow the spread of COVID-19, and in the best interests of both the drivers and passengers, the previously made changes at the Anniston Multimodal Center and the previously made changes with the Anniston Calhoun Transit System (ACTS) will be extended until April 30th, at which time they both shall be reevaluated. These changes include:

The **Anniston Multimodal Station** (Amtrak Station, Greyhound Station, Trolley Station) located at 126 West 4th Street, Anniston, AL 36201, will temporarily change its hours of operation to the following:

- Monday Friday: 8:00AM until 7:00PM
- <u>Saturday</u>: 9:00AM until 3:00PM
- <u>Sunday</u>: Closed

Until the station's April 30th reevaluation, an emergency phone line will be made available: <u>256-310-7723</u>.

The Anniston Calhoun Transit System (ACTS) fixed route will now allow only 5 passengers on the vehicle at any one time. In addition, fares are currently being waived, and Paratransit and Demand Response services will continue to provide essential transportation trips.
