In order to limit and slow the spread of COVID-19, beginning tomorrow, **March 24th**, the Anniston Multimodal Station (Amtrak Station, Greyhound Station, Trolley Station) located at 126 West 4th Street, Anniston, AL 36201, will temporarily change its hours of operation to the following:

• Monday - Friday: 8:00AM until 7:00PM

• Saturday: 9:00AM until 3:00PM

• Sunday: Closed

Please note, these changes shall remain in effect until April 6, 2020, at which time they will be reevaluated. Until the station's April reevaluation, an emergency phone line will be made available: <u>256-310-7723</u>.

Furthermore, in an effort to ensure the safety of those most vulnerable to COVID-19, the Anniston Senior Citizen & Therapeutic Recreation Center's **therapeutic program** will cease operation (*effective today*, *03/23/20*). The program will be reevaluated on 04/06/20, and the public will be promptly notified of any changes at that time.
