DO YOU NEED TO SURRENDER AN ANIMAL?

 In order to surrender an animal, at no cost, the owner must go to Anniston City Hall (4309 McClellan Blvd, Anniston, AL 36206) during normal business hours (7:00AM to 4:00PM) to obtain a voucher.

HOW DO YOU OBTAIN AN EMERGENCY VOUCHER?

- There will only be one voucher issued per family.
- In order to obtain a voucher, the resident must prove they reside in the City of Anniston Police Jurisdiction.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Until further notice, due to staffing shortages at the Calhoun County Animal Shelter, vouchers will only be issued in <u>emergency situations</u>. Each request will be evaluated on a case by case basis prior to a voucher being issued.

HOW DO YOU PROVE THAT YOU RESIDE IN THE ANNISTON POLICE JURISDICTION?



• For a resident to prove that they reside in the City of Anniston Police Jurisdiction, we will require the resident to present a state issued Driver's license or ID along with a utility bill or mortgage statement in their name.

WHAT DO YOU DO IF ADDRESS ON DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ID DOESN'T MATCH BILL/STATEMENT ADDRESS?

- If the resident's ID or Driver's License has a different address than the bill/statement, then a second bill/statement must be presented.
- The name on all documents must match.
- Once residency is verified, a voucher may be issued.
- The voucher, along with your driver's license or ID should then be taken to the Calhoun County Animal Shelter, as so you may surrender your animal.
