# Noble Street Festival Vendor Information and Application

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

The annual Noble Street Festival (NSF) is held in conjunction with the Sunny King Criterium (SKC), a professional cycling road race. The "Crit" draws professional, junior and amateur cyclists and cycling teams from around the world.

Attendance for the one-day event averages 8,000 with peak attendance from noon to 2 PM and again in the evening during the professional category men's and women's races. (Attendance not guaranteed.) Noble Street Festival is held along the 900 and 1000 blocks of Noble Street.

Vendor applications will be juried by the festival advisory team. Vendors with innovative and original products not currently offered by our downtown restaurants and retail businesses will receive priority. Commerical products are avoided. Only a select number of vendors will be accepted. We desire vendors that compliment our business community and enhance festival attendees' experiences; and we genuinely want you to be successful.

This is a juried event. Vendors accepted for vending will be notified within 2 weeks of receipt of application. If your application is denied, your check will be returned. Commerical products not allowed. For best consideration, include photographs or a website URL with images of your products for the festival advisory team to review and make their decision.

#### **PROMOTIONS**

NSF and the Sunny King Criterium are broadly promoted via radio, television, social media, State tourism department resources, local and regional newspapers and more. Vendors are expected to promote their participation in this event. Vendors registered by March 1 are included in the online NSF vendor listing.

#### SET UP/BREAK DOWN

Set-up Begins: Saturday, May 6th, from 6AM - 8AM

Set-up Complete/vehicles moved: By 8 AM Break Down: Saturday, May 6th, at 7 PM

A festival map will be e-mailed to vendors one week prior to the festival. Review this map so that upon arrival you know how to enter the festival, where to set up and where to park vehicles.

Spikes are not allowed in the pavement. Vendors are not permitted to exceed designated marked space. If you believe you will need more space than 10x10-ft, you are welcome to purchase an additional booth space.

#### PARKING AND TRAFFIC

The festival area and race course is closed to traffic in the early morning on the day of the festival. Understanding how to access the festival area for setup is important. In addition to your vending trailer/tent, you are allowed one vehicle in the vendor area to unload supplies during setup. All vehicles used for supplies must be removed from the festival area no later than 8 AM. Parking for vehicle(s) is available within walking distance from the vendor area. You will receive further instructions in advance e-mail communications.

#### WHAT WE EXPECT FROM OUR VENDORS

Only food vendors have access to electricity. Vendors are discouraged from bringing their own generators, as the city will instead work to provide electricity.

You will be expected to provide your own tables, tent, and

Bring trash bins/bags for trash generated by you and patrons at your booth. Please keep your vending area neat and clean.

REFUNDS, CANCELLATIONS or RAIN DATE. An accepted reservation is a commitment to participate in the festival and an acceptance of the disclaimer. Accepted vendors will be notified within 2 weeks of receipt of application. **Deadline for all vendor applications is April 10, 2023** Late applications will be automatically rejected.
