

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

The City of Anniston hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, gender, religion, age, disability, marital status or national origin in consideration for an award.

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Anniston until 10:00 am CST on February 8, 2024, at the City Clerk's Office, Anniston City Hall, 4309 McClellan Blvd, Anniston, AL 36202, and then shall be publicly opened and read aloud for the following:

Chief Ladiga Trail Shared Use Bike Path (City of Anniston Project #2015-024)

The bracket estimate on this project is from \$4,537,000 to \$5,221,000. The principal items of work are approximately as follows: **Grade, Drain, Base, and Pave, Signing, Striping, and Bridge**. The entire project shall be completed in 240 calendar days.

To be eligible for consideration, bids must be submitted on complete original proposals made available by the owner. Bid documents (including plans and proposals) are available by contacting Matt Stoops, PE at Sain Associates by email at mstoops@sain.com. The bid documents are also available for viewing only at the city clerk's office.

A Prebid Meeting shall be held at Anniston City Hall, Large Conference Room, on January 25, 2024 at 10 am. This is a **mandatory** prebid meeting.

A cashier's check (drawn on an Alabama bank) or bid bond for 5% of the amount bid (maximum of \$50,000.00) and made payable to the City of Anniston must accompany each bid as evidence of good faith.

Proposals will be issued only to and accepted from contractors on the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) list of pre-qualified contractors. The award of the contract will be made only to a contractor who has a valid certification of qualification from ALDOT as required by state law and will not be made to any bidder who is considered by ALDOT to be disqualified from bidding, or is an affiliate of or has a corporate officer, director, or principal owner who is a corporate officer, director, or owner of, another person who is presently disqualified by ALDOT.

The proposed work shall be performed in conformity with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations.

The right to reject any or all bids is reserved.
